- ANYTOWN staff and former delegates will be present who may be able to answer questions or comment on the ANYTOWN experience.



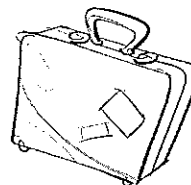
What should I pack for ANYTOWN?

Required Items

- Unscented Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb, etc.- Keep in mind that **bugs are attracted to scents.**)
- Extra linen (Linen and towels are provided but you may want to bring an additional towel, blanket or pillow).
- Clothes (Keep it simple with jeans, t-shirts, shorts, sweatshirts or a jacket. It gets cold in the mountains.
- Rain gear
- Pajamas
- Sturdy shoes (**No Flip Flops** are allowed except for use in showers. **Sandals must have a back or they cannot be worn.**)
- Sunglasses, hats and sunscreen/block (These items are encouraged for your own protection.

Optional Items

- Musical Instruments that are not electric. (Guitars and harmonicas are encouraged.)
- Camera
- Stationery (You may want to write to your friends or family.)
- CDs (Your cabin counselor may have a boom box for your cabin).
- Money (You may want to purchase drinks that are sold during afternoon breaks. If you decide to bring money, know that a little will last a long time.)
- Items from your culture



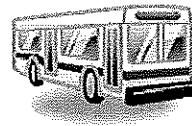
What are the rules for ANYTOWN?

- **No drugs, alcohol, weapons, gambling, smoking or sexual activity. (NO DAWGSS!)**
 - No portable DVD or video players.
 - You are not allowed to be in the cabin of the opposite sex for any reason or at any time.
 - ANYTOWN delegates cannot leave the BRCC property at any time and you cannot invite anyone to BRCC.
 - **You must commit to the entire week of ANYTOWN.**
 - No walkmans, discmans, ipods or mp3 players.
 - **Absolutely no cell phones, pagers, walkie-talkies or other communication devices of any sort.**
- *Note: If any of the rules in **BOLD** are broken, your parents will called and asked to come and pick you up.

How do I get to ANYTOWN?

- Chartered bus transportation is provided for all delegates. No delegates may drive to ANYTOWN. The buses will depart at **2:00PM (sharp) on Sunday, August 1, 2010** from:

- **Please arrive in the parking lot no later than 1:00PM.** If you need directions to Smith High School, please call the NCCJ Office at 336-272-0359.
 - Prior to boarding the bus, there will be a medical screening.
 - Please **eat lunch before you arrive** in the parking lot.

How do I get back from ANYTOWN?

- The buses will return to **Smith High School on Friday, August 6, 2010 at 5:45PM.**
- Please make arrangements before you leave for ANYTOWN to have someone pick you up.
- Be sure your ride home is **on time!**

Is there anything else I need to do or know before ANYTOWN?

- **Have you paid your tuition in full?**
 - If you have any question about your fees or you cannot pay by the due date, please call Alison Jones, NCCJ Office Manager at 336-272-0359.
 - There will be no refunds after July 1, 2010.
- **Did you sign and submit your medical form?**
 - You will not be allowed to board the bus without completing this form.
 - You are NOT required to have a doctor complete the medical form.
- **Did you call the NCCJ Office if your plans changed?**
 - If your summer plans have changed and you will no longer be able to attend ANYTOWN, please call the NCCJ office ASAP.
