NCCJ's annual **Brotherhood/Sisterhood Citation Award Dinner** celebrates our community's commitment to diversity and inclusion. As our largest community program, it's an opportunity to share our mission and showcase our work with more than 1,000 community and business leaders from across the Triad. Each year at the Dinner, we present the Brotherhood/Sisterhood Citation Award to outstanding community leaders who are fighting bias, bigotry, and racism and working to make the Triad a better place for all of us – not just some of us. As NCCJ's major fundraising initiative, the Citation Award Dinner also provides the support we need to keep our doors open throughout the year.

NCCJ's **Interfaith Tour** brings people of all faiths and belief systems together for an afternoon of community building as we tour different houses of worship across the Triad. It offers a unique opportunity to hear from a diverse group of faith leaders in our community and develop a stronger appreciation of different belief systems. It's free, fun, and family-friendly.

Co-sponsored by the Greensboro Jewish Federation and the Community Foundation of Greater Greensboro, the **Interfaith Study Mission** is a triennial program that builds bridges of understanding by bringing together an interfaith group of Triad residents to travel through Israel and Palestine, the land where three major faith groups (Judaism, Christianity, and Islam) originated. Participants return to the Triad prepared to assume larger leadership roles that transcend religious boundaries.

NCCJ's **Let's Talk Series** brings people from all walks of life together for guided discussions on topics such as Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), Unconscious Bias, and other issues affecting neighbors here in our community. These facilitated community dialogues offer a welcoming environment for participants to learn and connect across lines of difference.
